The campaign aims to help prevent accidents and life-threatening events at workplaces in the field of occupational health and safety, while in labour-law relations labour inspection focuses primarily on preventing undeclared employment and tackling undeclared work.

## Employment Culture Conference

In order to provide answers on labour-law relations issues, labour inspection attention is primarily directed to preventing illegal employment and combating undeclared work. The fight against undeclared work is one of the priorities of the European Union, and it is also gaining momentum in Slovak conditions. Therefore, the NLI seeks to provide information to employers and employees in the form of prevention and awareness raising activities as widely as possible through various tools and activities.

The NLI, in cooperation with the trade union OZ KOVO, will organize a conference entitled “Culture of Employment”, the aim of which will be to bring the most up-to-date information concerning legal work, legal employment and combating undeclared work.





As part of the campaign, the NLI prepared an awareness video aimed at highlighting the benefits of legal work over illegal work. There are two versions of the video:



The "Safe Enterprise" programme is a tool to support the introduction of an effective OSH management system and to improve the level of OSH for employers in the Slovak Republic.


In particular, the programme aims to encourage and motivate employers to introduce and apply an OSH management system that is proportionate to the activities and conditions in the organization and which leads to a continuous improvement in OSH level and compliance with legislation in all areas of labour protection.
